## HOME LEARNING USING GOOGLE CLASSROOM

Dear Parents,

I hope this letter finds you well! Thank you all very much for your continued support and hard work over the past few weeks. Home Learning packs, for the next four weeks, will be available for collection from the school playground on Friday morning between 10.30am- 12noon. Please return your child's first Home Learning pack (including reading books & library books) into the boxes provided. Library books will also be available - please feel free to select a few for your child/ren.

From next week, Monday 27<sup>th</sup> April, Google Classroom will be our main learning forum for all children, therefore it is very important that children log in to Google Classroom every day to see their assigned work. Teachers will set daily work as 'assignments' under *Classwork*, so that completed tasks can be '**Handed In**' for teachers to correct and return to the children individually. This also allows the option for 'private' comments that only the child and teacher can see. Please refer to the video on the school website with instructions on how to '**Hand In**' assignments. *Please note: 'Handing In' assignments on a mobile device is different than on a laptop/desktop computer.* When necessary, teachers will also attach videos, voiceovers & slideshows, to explain new concepts/topics. Teachers are available through Google Classroom and email to answer your queries and offer guidance on your child's learning.

Teachers will continue to post on the '*Stream*' of Google Classroom so the children can communicate with them and the other children. Keep posting photographs of the children please!

As a staff, we are still missing each and every one of our 'children' and you, our wonderful parents. Remember we are all in this together & we are 'Living through History'.
