

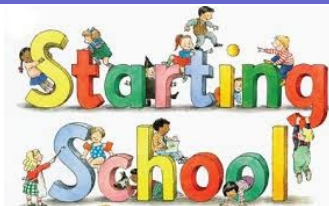
St. Mary's Primary School
